



METHOD PART 1:
(to be completed at the event)

1. Fill your bowl half full with compost
2. Add 3 spoons of Flour (we are using GF) (your bowl should now be 3/4 full)
3. add one spoon of seeds
4. Mix together with a spoon so it's nice and evenly combined
5. empty your mix into your bag ready to take home



METHOD PART 2:
(to be completed at home)

1. Empty your prepared mix into a bowl
2. Add a small cup of water in little bits, mixing as you go. You want to do this gradually and keep mixing until you have a firm sticky consistency
3. Gently roll the mixture in your hand to form a golf ball sized ball
4. Place the balls in a tray or box and allow them to dry for 24 hours



TIPS FOR SUCCESS:

Ideally, seed bombs should be made the day before rain is forecast and then cast 24 hours later – hopefully before the rain has started! If it doesn't rain then no matter, the seeds will be fine. If you are concerned that birds will eat the seeds then add a little paprika to the mix. It won't hurt them but they don't like it!
